Liability Insurance

- Selective quote for 2022 coverage, \$61,801
 - o Full Earthquake coverage of 19 million
- EMC quote for 2022 coverage, \$59,882
 - We had EMC in the past and they are aggressively seeking our business
 - Earthquake coverage for only 10 million
 - o \$50,000 in cyber liability protection

- Current cyber protection is becoming harder to obtain for public entities. Next year the renewal
 will be a separate policy with a monoline carrier. This will come with a 2-step authentication
 requirement for all logging into programs for the town.
